Background

He has presented papers to various IBC Trust Conferences, the American College of Trust and Estate Counsel, the Pennsylvania Bar Association, the Oklahoma Bar Association and the Strategy Institute (Toronto).

Gordon was born in Toronto, Canada, in 1944. He received a B.A. in 1966 and LL.B in 1969, both from the University of Toronto, Canada. He was called to the Bar in Ontario, Canada, in 1971 and in Bermuda in 1996. He was appointed a Queen's Counsel by the Lieutenant-Governor of Ontario in December, 1984.
